Purgatory Resort Company Profile

Durango, Colo. — (Winter 2024-2025) — Purgatory is tucked away between Durango and Silverton on the San Juan Skyway Scenic and Historic Byway, on the southern edge of the San Juan Mountains. Purgatory offers 1,635 skiable acres, 4 terrain parks, 11 lifts, and 107 trails from wide-open cruisers to steep tree skiing. New this season, Purgatory announces several upgrades across the resort, including enhancements to the Hermosa Park Express Lift #3 and the expansion of Purgatory's retail footprint.

One of Colorado's most family-friendly and best value ski resorts, Purgatory is thrilled to continue offering <u>Power</u> <u>Kids</u>, the only season pass in North American that offers unlimited free skiing and snowboarding for all children 12 and younger, no blackout dates or purchase required. Lift tickets for the 2024-2025 season are on sale now, with prices starting \$9 on select dates. With Purgatory's demand-based pricing, lift ticket prices rise with demand. Purgatory's dynamic pricing strategy rewards guests who plan ahead and helps the resort manage the flow of visitors during peak periods, reducing lift lines and enhancing the guest experience.

Signature events and on-mountain activities include New Year's Eve fireworks, live music, pond skimming, tubing, and the year-round mountain coaster. Visitors can dine at the Village Plaza base area or take in the views at one of Purgatory's mountain lodges. Overnight accommodations range from slopeside studios to luxurious penthouse suites. Purgatory Snowcat Adventures is Colorado's largest guided snowcat operation, with access to over 35,000 acres of expert terrain in the San Juan backcountry, plus scenic tours and Snowcat dining excursions for the whole family.

Purgatory Resort Announces 2024-25 Winter Operating Schedule

Durango, CO — (September 3, 2024) — Purgatory Resort, one of Colorado's most family-friendly and affordable ski resorts, is excited to unveil its 2024-25 winter operating schedule. This winter, Purgatory Resort will be open daily from November 16, 2024, to April 13, 2025, with weekend operations continuing Friday through Sunday until April 27, 2025.

This season features a series of capital improvements and new initiatives designed to enhance the guest experience and make skiing more accessible for everyone. One of the most notable upgrades this season is the enhancement of the Hermosa Park Express Lift #3. As a crucial lift on the mountain, essential for transporting guests from the backside to the frontside, Lift #3 will be modernized with a low voltage safety control system. This upgrade will ensure the lift's reliability for years to come, improving access to the popular backside trails.

In addition to the Lift #3 upgrade, Purgatory is expanding its retail footprint and will introduce four new pickup stations for online purchases. Guests will now be able to scan their purchase confirmation and head straight to the lifts within 30 seconds, bypassing the ticket office entirely.

The Village Market & Deli is also undergoing a complete renovation, introducing an all-new menu and atmosphere. The updated selection will feature local and NOSH (natural, organic, specialty and healthy) grocery items, while the Powderhouse Lodge will see another phase of improvements to its interior and exterior infrastructure, along with a new retro theme.

Building on the significant cleanup work in Poet's Glade last year, the Trail Maintenance team has been hard at work improving other popular tree skiing zones on the mountain, including Who, Mark's Park, When, What, Hoody's, and McCormack's Maze. These efforts, focused on removing deadfall and standing dead trees, reduce forest fuel loading and enhance skier safety by clearing snags and ground obstacles.

A cornerstone of Purgatory's commitment to accessibility is Power Kids, the only season pass in North America that provides unlimited free skiing for kids aged 12 and under, with no purchase required and no blackout dates.

Tickets for the 2024-25 season are now on sale, providing guests with the opportunity to secure the best deals through Purgatory's demand-based pricing strategy. This dynamic model adjusts ticket prices in real-time based on demand, rewarding those who purchase early with the lowest prices available. Durango, CO — (November 7, 2024) — Purgatory Resort, one of Colorado's most family friendly and best value ski resorts, will open for a bonus weekend of skiing on Saturday and Sunday, November 9-10, 2024, following nearly a foot of snowfall over the past 48 hours. Purgatory will open for daily operations on November 16, as scheduled.

Purgatory Resort Rings in the New Year with Exciting Event Lineup


